We really must be entering a sort of alternative universe in pro sports. After all, in the last six years, we've seen teams from Tampa/St. Pete, Raleigh, and Anaheim win the Stanley Cup; the Red Sox and White Sox each break near century-long World Series droughts; and the Saints win the Super Bowl. *Okay, the Cubs have yet to get back to the World Series, but you get the idea: almost anything seems possible in sports these days.* Which is why no one is even pausing to reflect upon the unlikely development of Bill Bidwill's Cardinals becoming NFL playoff regulars, a concept that long seemed about as unlikely as Fox News' Alan Colmes ever marrying someone who looks as good as Monica Crowley (*wait, that happened, too!*).

Bill Bidwill, of course, has wisely stepped aside in the day-to-day operations of the club. Son Michael now runs the show and was the force behind HC Ken Whisenhunt being lured to the desert from Bill Cowher's Pittsburgh staff. Which has turned into quite an inspired hire, as Whisenhunt has steered Arizona to those back-to-back postseason berths and a Super Bowl XLIII slot, and has presided over an improving record each of his three seasons, from 8 to 9 to 10 wins. *Continuing that trendline this fall, however, might not be easy.*

Specifically, it's because the Cardinals are entering some uncharted territory after the retirement of QB Kurt Warner, whose veteran presence triggered the recent Big Red renaissance. Being handed the keys to the car is southpaw Matt Leinart, who has endured a bumpy ride over the past few years. Warner's resurrection wasn't the only development that slowed Leinart's career; Leinart contributed plenty to the delay, in particular his fast-paced lifestyle that didn't play as well with Whisenhunt as it did in L.A. during Leinart's Heisman Trophy-winning, rock-star days at USC. Not only was his maturity doubted by Whisenhunt, but Matt's footwork also remained sloppy, and his passes still tended to sail. *Regardless, "Coach Wiz" is hoping Leinart learned something by going from backup to starter as a rookie, starter to backup in his second season, preseason starter to backup in his third year, third-stringer to backup in his fourth year, and now back to starter in his fifth season.* He's also playing to salvage his career; Leinart's salary is slated to increase another \$5 million in 2011, and he could earn an additional \$5 million roster bonus. But if Leinart doesn't deliver this fall, Whisenhunt likely won't want him back, and certainly not at those numbers.

To keep a fire lit under Leinart, Whisenhunt has added former Browns starter Derek Anderson, who might not be much of an alternative after posting a lowly 42.1 passer rating in '09 with Cleveland. NFC West sources also believe Whisenhunt might be uncomfy enough with Leinart and Anderson that he could still pursue another QB, perhaps ex-Ram Marc Bulger. *Stay tuned for further developments this summer.*

The switch at QB isn't the only change in the Big Red offense, which figures to become more run-based post-Warner, which would certainly help Leinart sell play-action (one of his strengths) a bit better. Beanie Wells (hopefully beyond some of his fumble problems as a rookie LY) and Tim Hightower are a potentially-punishing RB tandem, although four of the five offensive linemen are either new (including ex-Jet FA G Alan Faneca) or playing different positions from a year ago. And the long-rumored departure of WR Anquan Boldin (traded to Baltimore) means Steve Breaston now steps into a more featured role complementing Larry Fitzgerald, with another wideout (*perhaps Early Doucet*) needed to step into Breaston's old third-WR role. Free agent addition Jay Feely also figures as a more reliable clutch PK than the departed Neil Rackers.

A "D" that was strafed for 90 points and 911 yards in the playoffs vs. the Packers and Saints required d.c. Bill Davis to patch some holes in the offseason. With key components LB Karlos Dansby & S Antrel Rolle departing, expect five new starters, including first-round pick NT Dan Williams (Tennessee), whose ability to plug the middle should allow Davis to switch to his preferred 3-4, and LB Daryl Washington, a 2nd-round pick from TCU. Davis would rather not have to scheme and blitz as much to rattle enemy QBs, and to that end he needs DE Calais Campbell to continue his improvement and prevent foes from tag-teaming Darnell Dockett on the other side. Though now 33, FA OLB Joey Porter (9 sacks LY with Miami) can still deliver the sort of pressure from the edge this "D" requires, while another FA, ex-Jet FS Kerry Rhodes, is slated to start alongside intimidating SS Adrian Wilson.

Bottom line...The Cards have been winning the NFC West almost by default the past two seasons. But, with as many as nine new starters from '09, and replacing the invaluable Kurt Warner, the Big Red enters this fall as something of a mystery team. *A return to the playoffs is no guarantee.*

PRESEASON NOTES: Whisenhunt has low-keyed it in preseason, going 2-10 SU and 3-9 vs. the spread (0-6 when favored) in three years.
