Last year's strong 4-0 finish by Houston had wide-ranging benefits. One, it meant the first winning season in the Texans' eight-year history—finally—after 8-8 in 2007 and 2008. Second, it helped save the job of HC Gary Kubiak, whose future might have been curtailed in Houston had his team faded to, say, 6-10. Instead, Kubiak earned an extension through 2012. Third, it meant more big bucks for QB Matt Schaub, who stayed healthy all season and passed for a lofty 4770 yards, was named MVP of the Pro Bowl, gained a \$10 million contract bonus, plus a three-year contract extension. As Borat would say, "nice!!!" Fourth, the fast finish buoyed long-suffering owner Bob McNair, who believes his team is now on track to the playoffs in its ninth season. "We have a foundation in place," says McNair. "We don't have to go out and establish the foundation, which is what we've been doing for the last eight years. We've got some outstanding players, and we just have to keep building on that."

That is true, borne out by last year's numbers. On offense, the Texans were No. 1 in passing, No. 30 in rushing, No. 4 in total yards, and No. 10 in points. On defense, No. 12 vs. the run, No. 18 vs. the pass, No. 14 overall, and No. 17 in points against. To Kubiak—and to everybody else who understands those basic rankings, what Houston has to do to advance the next step is to upgrade its ground game in order to balance its offense, and to further improve a young defense to playoff level.

Kyle Shanahan, last year's offensive coordinator, has moved to Washington to work for father Mike. But the offense will remain unchanged with the addition of Rick Dennison, a long-time compatriot of Kubiak and the elder Shanahan in Denver. The aerial game is expected to be very productive once again, even though star WR Andre Johnson wants his contract redone after a massive 216 catches, 3144 yards, and 17 TDC the last two years; TE Owen Daniels is returning from his *third* ACL operation (one each in HS, college, and the pros); and talented Jacoby Jones is still wildly inconsistent. But Kubiak, a former QB, has always found receivers. The steady Kevin Walter had 53 recs. LY. Versatile James Casey and No. 4 pick Garrett Graham have futures at TE or H-back. 5-5 LSU sprinter Trindon Holliday (the fastest player in the draft at 4.21) will train at both wideout and returner, and No. 7 pick Dorin Dickerson (TE at Pitt) is working at WR.

But it's likely to be a story of no rush offense, no playoffs in Houston. Says Kubiak, "We can go out there and throw it with anybody in the business. I don't think that's what's best for our team in the long run. We've got to be more dominant late in games. Some games we lost, it was because we couldn't hang onto the football late in those games." Indeed, 6 of the Texans' 7 losses were by 8 points or fewer. And Houston's OL isn't one of the league's best, lacking power blockers up front such as those owned by the Jets, Titans, Panthers or Ravens. Kubiak is counting on a return to form by darting RB Steve Slaton, who fell from 1282 YR in 2008 to only 437 LY, gaining only 3.3 ypc and fumbling 7 times due to a neck injury that required cervical fusion surgery. Slaton has dropped about 15 pounds in the offseason, with No. 2 pick Ben Tate (5-11, 220) of Auburn expected to provide Houston with a bigger inside-the-tackles option.

The defense will be without top tackler Brian Cushing (133 Ts, 4 sacks) for the first four games for violating the NFL's substance-abuse regulations. Twice elected A.P. Defensive Rookie of the Year (once before the NFL suspension, once again in a re-vote), Cushing will miss games vs. Indy, Washington, Dallas & Oakland. He is among the core group of quality Texan defenders that includes DE Mario Williams, DT Okoye Amobi, MLB DeMeco Ryans, OLB Zac Diles, CB Glover Quin, and S Bernard Pollard, the latter falling into Houston's lap early LY when released by Kansas City. This year's Texans' No. 1 pick, CB Kareem Jackson, trained by Nick Saban at Alabama, will be given every chance to start, while No. 4 LB Darryl Sharpton of Miami (Rev. Al is his uncle!) will battle to sub for Cushing. It is hoped No. 3 DT Earl Mitchell (6½ sacks LY at Arizona) will help the inside pass rush for a team that had only 30 QB takedowns LY and whose front four has lost weight, hoping to improve quickness in 2010. PK Kris Brown (only 21 of 32 FGs LY) will have to fend off veteran Neil Rackers TY.

**Bottom Line...**Houston's OL is not one of the NFL's best. Matt Schaub has had injury issues in the past. And the defense needs more sacks. A healthy return by Slaton would be a plus. But Texas is still unlikely to run past Indy in the AFC South.

**PRESEASON NOTES:** Kubiak is 9-7 SU ( 9-5-2 vs. the number) in four preseasons in Houston, *but 1-4-2 as a favorite vs. 8-1 as a dog!!!*
