Kansas City made only minor progress LY (to 4-12 from 2-14 in 2008) in its first season under rookie HC Todd Haley. However, the Chiefs seem well positioned to advance another step in 2010. Offseason moves appear to be more positive than LY, when the tough-love Haley rode his initial group of players *and coaches* (offensive coordinator Chan Gailey was demoted after just three exhibitions) harder than they anticipated concerning their commitment, work habits, and execution. K.C. got off to an 0-5 start, not completely a shock after changing offensive and defensive systems and turning the attack over young QB Matt Cassel, who had only one previous season of starting in four years of the NFL after none in college. But the Chiefs won 4 of their last 7 games, getting through the midseason flare-up that led to the suspension and subsequent release of top RB Larry Johnson. K.C.'s victories came against Washington, Oakland, Pittsburgh (in OT), and slumping Denver in the finale; only the Steelers (9-7) had a winning record.

The offseason featured the addition of more coaching power that helps shape the Chiefs even more like the "Patriots West" after they already had longtime N.E. front-office guy Scott Pioli as GM and Cassel as their QB. Joining Haley TY are former Notre Dame coach Charlie Weis and Cleveland Browns coach Romeo Crennel, who will handle the offense and defense, respectively, just as they did when winning three Super Bowls on Bill Belichick's staff. Moreover, taking over the Chiefs' big-play-yielding secondary will be Emmitt Thomas, the Hall of Famer who is the all-time K.C. leader in ints. with 58 and who has served as defensive coordinator for several teams, winning two Super Bowl rings on the Redskins staff to go with his own won as a Chiefs CB vs. the Vikings in SB IV.

Many are predicting an inevitable power clash on Haley's staff, but everything is rosy heading into camp, as Cassel now has Tom Brady's old playcaller (Weis) to guide him, the sometimes-confused K.C. defense has a 3-4 "doctor" in the house (Crennel), and the youthful secondary has a deluxe role model (Thomas). To add on-the-field leadership, Pioli has signed veteran free-agent RB Thomas Jones (1402 YR with the Jets LY), G Ryan Lilja from the Colts, former Chief G/C Casey Wiegmann (back after two years with the Broncos), and situational receiver Jerheme Urban (played for Haley in Arizona). The idea is to make the attack more consistent after Cassel completed only 55% LY with just 16 TDs vs. 16 interceptions.

With RB Jones dividing carries with breakaway-type Jamaal Charles (1120 YR, 5.9 ypc LY), Haley hopes to open more space for his underachieving receiving corps. The inconsistent Dwayne Bowe (47 recs. LY; down from 86 in '08) and fading Chris Chambers (36) have experience, but Pioli hopes 5-8 lightning bug Dexter McCCluster (1169 YR, 6.5 ypc; 44 recs.) can help primarily as a wideout after excelling LY at Ole Miss as a RB, often taking direct snaps in the "Wild Rebel." And Haley hopes to get more production at TE, adding No. 3 pick Tony Moeaki from Iowa and having 6-7 Brad Cottam healthy after LY's neck problems.

The greater concerns are on defense (30th LY) than on offense. The young secondary is taking shape, as CBs Brandon Flowers (5 ints.) & Brandon Carr have bright futures. S Jarrad Page is trying to come back from a calf injury, but No. 1 pick S Eric Berry is considered a special defender with great versatility and ball skills (14 ints. in 3 years at Tennessee). Berry and CB/KR Javier Arenas (Alabama) are considered "NFL ready" after being coached by Monte Kiffin & Nick Saban, respectively. Berry is likely to start, while Arenas (who has a knack for blitzing) seems slated for early action at nickel-back.

The key problem area for Crennel is the DL, where 2008 No. 1 pick Glenn Dorsey and 2009 No. 1 Tyson Jackson have failed to develop into impact big men and are still learning the nuances of the 3-4 after playing in a 4-3 at LSU. The Tiger pair combined for exactly *uno* sack LY of K.C.'s lowly 22 (only the Jags were worse). OLB/DE Tamba Hali led the way with 8½, while former NYG practice squader Wallace Gilberry surprised with 4½. Crennel will also try to light a fire under another former top pick, ILB Derrick Johnson.

Says in-your-face HC Haley of building his team, "We don't care how you got here. Once you're here, you're just another helmet with a piece of tape on it, and we're going to try to figure out if you can help us win." Cool!

Bottom Line...K.C. seems ready to escape the AFC West cellar. To challenge San Diego? Not yet.

PRESEASON NOTES: Despite being a disciple of Bill Parcells, Haley was 0-4 SU and vs. the spread in the preseason LY (losses by 6, 4, 4, 8). K.C. is 1-11 vs. the spread the last three preseasons!
