Last year's strange 7-9 Miami season begin with three frustrating losses and ended with three frustrating losses. The ensuing Dolphins' offseason was also strange in some respects, including GM Jeff Ireland apologizing for asking Oklahoma State WR Dez Bryant at one point in a pre-draft interview whether his mother was a prostitute. That bizarre incident is unlikely to be forgotten, nor is the 2009 Miami campaign during which the defending AFC East champs saw their defense desert them time and again while they were transitioning to a rookie CB pair and being forced to speed up the development of young QB Chad Henne after veteran Chad Pennington went down with a shoulder injury in Game Three.

Along the way in 2009, the Dolphins swept the Jets and split with the Pats, but suffered many agonizing defeats. Miami out-rushed Indy 239 to 61 and controlled the clock for 14:53, but still lost 27-23 to Peyton Manning and the Colts on Monday Night Football. The Dolphins had the Saints on the ropes 24-3, but came apart to lose 46-34. They gave up 21 points in the fourth quarter to lose at Buffalo 31-14. They lost in OT at Tennessee after coming back from 24-6 in the third quarter. And, with the playoffs still a possibility, Miami dropped its finale 30-24 to Pittsburgh when QBs Henne & Patrick White were both knocked from the game. The Dolphins lost No. 1 RB/Wildcat QB Ronnie Brown with a dreaded Lisfranc fracture of his foot in Game Nine. And, with his defense (24th vs. the pass, 25th in points) criticized for being too predictable and too soft, coordinator Paul Pasqualoni was dismissed in January.

However, from the ashes of 2009 have sprung *beaucoup* reasons for hope in 2010. Strong-armed, third-year QB Chad Henne (61%, 12 TDs, 14 ints.; team-record 17 straight completions in Game 13) developed nicely and appears ready to be a leader of the offense. RB Ricky Williams (1121 YR, 4.7 ypc) carried the load so well in Brown's absence that the 33-year-old says he might not retire following TY after all. Davone Bess (76 recs., but only 2 TDs) blossomed as a receiver. To give Henne the big-time target the Dolphins have been missing, VP Bill Parcells traded two No. 2 picks for sometimes troublesome 6-4 WR Brandon Marshall (102, 104, 101 recs. with Denver the L3Ys). And he dealt the disappointing Ted Ginn Jr. to San Francisco. Parcells has worked before with "temperamental" players (Terry Glenn, Keyshawn Johnson, Terrell Owens), so it's no surprise he signed Marshall (four years, \$48 million: 24 guaranteed) and then powerful hot-head G Richie Incognito, dumped by the Rams LY, then the Bills. Brittle QB Pennington was re-signed to be the No. 3 QB, with HC Tony Sparano saying White (termed by one reporter as "borderline terrible" as a passer) and Tyler Thigpen will fight it out for the No. 2 job.

With the exception of Marshall, more attention was paid to the defense (7 of 8 draft picks) than the offense in the offseason. Former S.F. HC Mike Nolan (with Denver LY) is the new defensive coordinator, espousing an aggressive style of 3-4, dating from his earlier years with the Ravens. It's a big plus that second-year CBs Sean Smith (16 starts) and Vontae Davis (9 starts; 4 ints.) have a season under their belts. S Jeremiah Bell led the team with 114 Ts LY, and 214-pound No. 5 pick Reshad Jones from Georgia has shown he might challenge at FS. Fellow No. 5, CB Nolan Carroll, has flashed better-than-expected speed. Aging OLBs Joey Porter & Jason Taylor combined for 16 sacks LY, but were allowed to leave in the interest of youth and speed looking forward. The younger additions at LB are headlined by vet Karlos Dansby (5 years, \$43 million) from Arizona, FA Tim Dobbins from San Diego, No. 2 Misi Koa from Utah, and No. 4 A.J. Edds from Iowa. It is hoped the athletic Koa can join holdover Cameron Wake (5½ sacks) as quality pass rushers.

The defensive line is in a period of adjustment, with starting NT Jason Ferguson (36 in November) re-signed despite his 8-game NFL substance-abuse suspension to begin the season. Randy Starks (7 sacks at DE LY) is moving to NT to split time with Paul Soliai, with No. 1 pick Jared Odrick (7 sacks LY at Penn State) learning the 3-4 DE position. 2008 No. 2 pick Phillip Merling has disappointed.

Volatile WR Marshall, now married, says his wife has helped him, "To be more patient; to think things through...Having the spotlight on you at all times, you have to make the right decisions and say the right things." With millions in the bank, minor hip surgery in spring, and the temptations of south Florida looming, Marshall's new-found maturity will be severely challenged.

Bottom Line...Offense, *si*. It's the defense that must improve if the Dolphins are to be swimming with the Jets and Pats come December.

PRESEASON NOTES: Parcells disciple Tony Sparano has flashed "Parcells Form" in the preseason, going 7-1 SU, 6-1-1 vs. the spread (4-0 away and as a dog).
